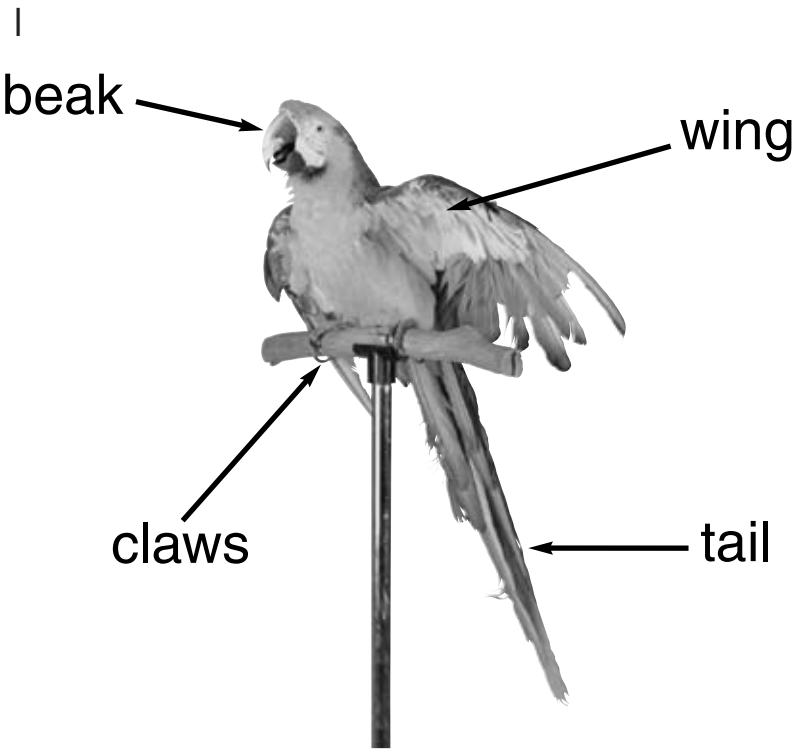

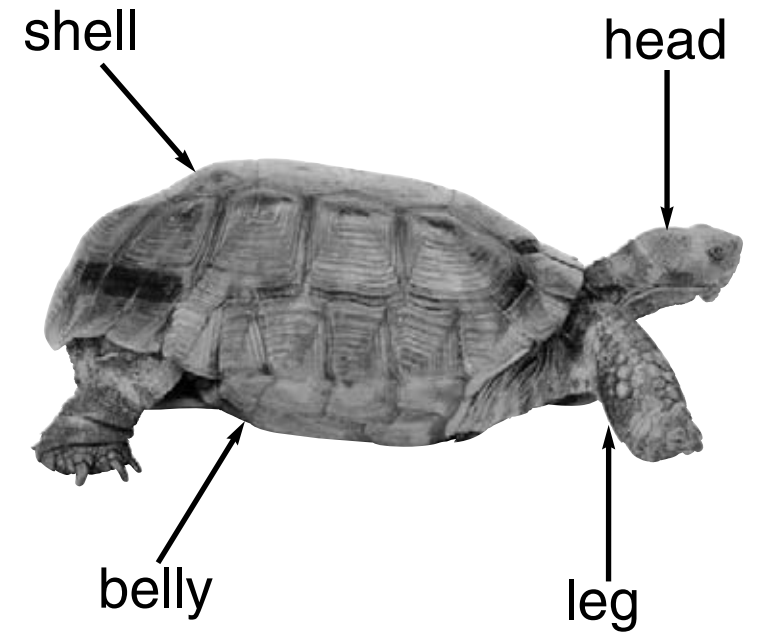

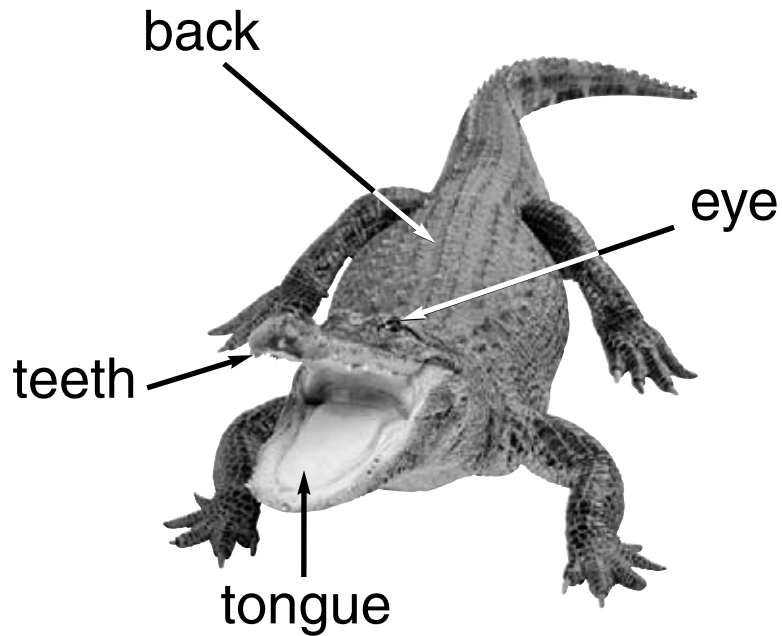
Parrot

 It is very safe inside the shell.



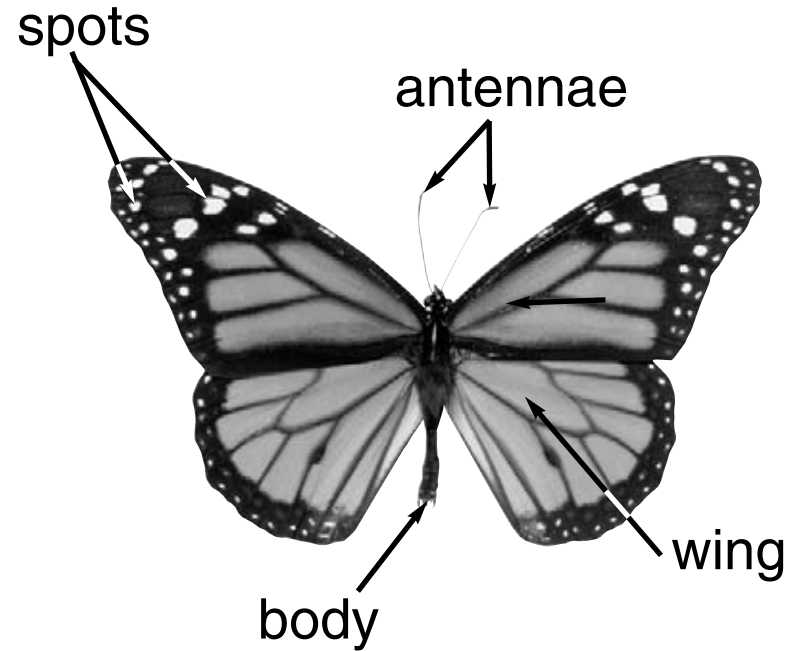
Alligator

Butterfly

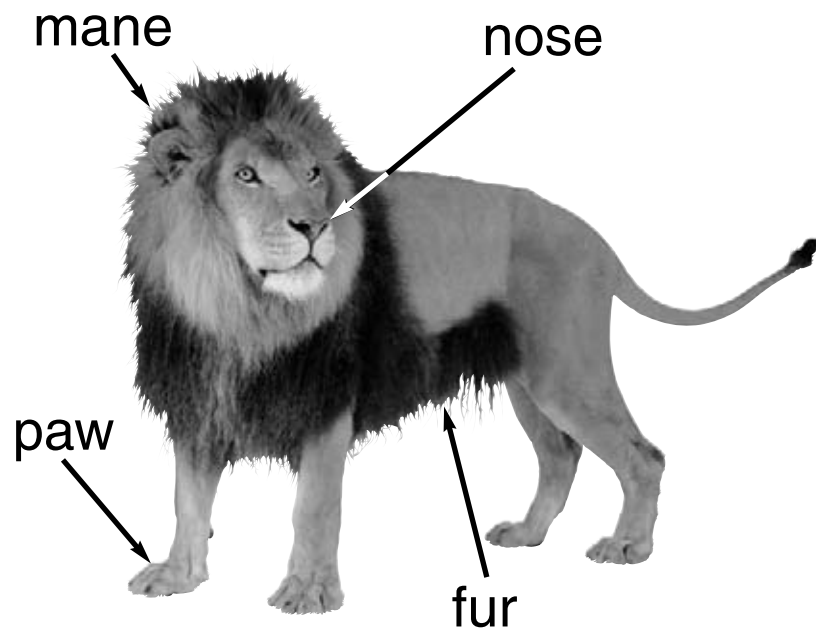
A butterfly is a flying insect.

A lion is a big cat.

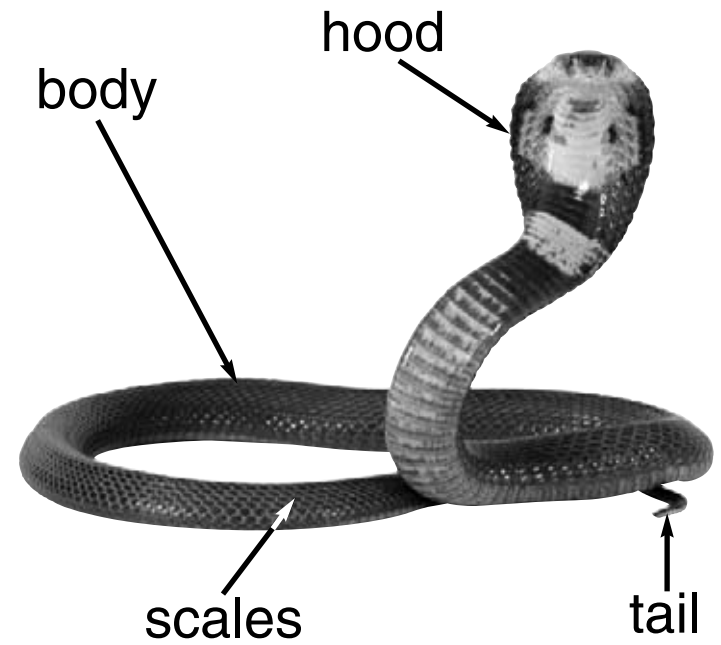
It uses its nose to smell prey.

Male lions have big manes.



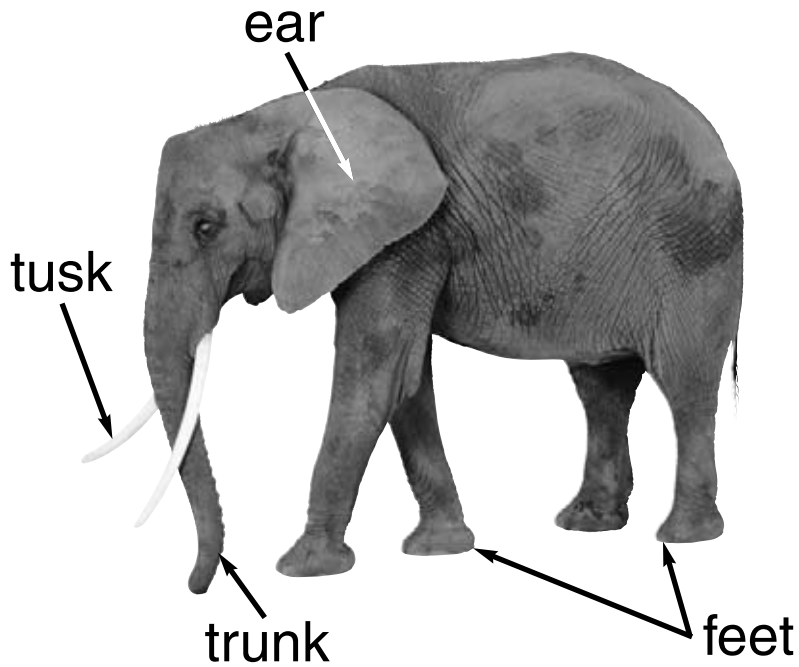
Cobra

It has a slim body and no legs.

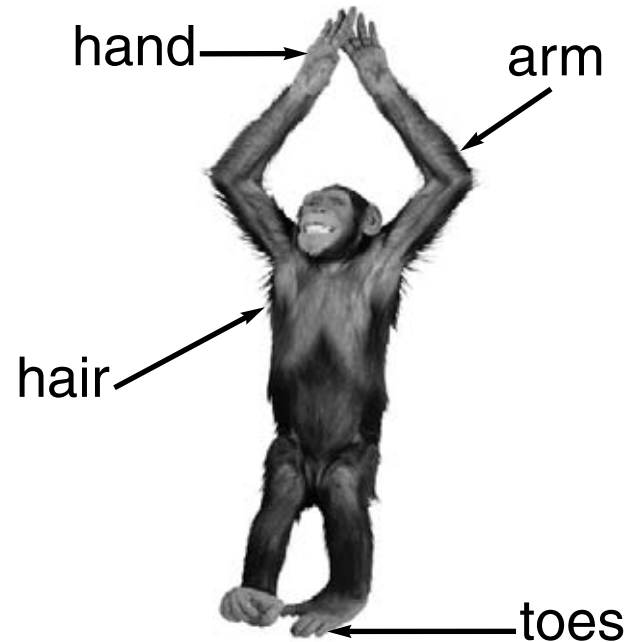
Small scales cover the cobra
