



Instructions: Read the high-frequency words above aloud with students. Have them cut the cards apart to use in one or more of the following activities:


- I. Combine two sets of cards to play Concentration.

Instructions: Have students name, color, and cut out the seasonal foods. Then have them paste the foods onto the Cornucopia worksheet.






Instructions: Have students color all of the hidden "A"s in the drawing orange. Have them color all of the animals and objects that start with "A" using another color.


Instructions: Read the paragraph below. Write a short summary about the harvest moon in the space provided.

As a result, the sun's light will be replaced by the moon's light at the same time every evening for several evenings in a row. 
