

Simple Future

Instructions

1. Person 1 will ask a question to Person 2.
2. Person 2 will answer in a complete sentence, using the **Simple Future** tense.
3. Person 2 will then ask the same question to Person 1 (or Person 3 if there are three people in the group).
4. Move to the next question once everyone has answered.

Questions with Be - Irregular Verb

- **Definition:** To exist in the world, or to describe someone or something.

Going to (Plans):

- What time are you going to be home tonight?

Will (Predictions):

- How tired will you be after school?

Questions with Have - Irregular Verb

- **Definition:** To possess, own, or hold something.

Going to (Plans):

- How many children will you have in the future?

Will (Predictions/General Future):

- What kind of house will you have when you're older?

Questions with Go - Irregular Verb

- **Definition:** To move from one place to another.

Going to (Plans):

- Where are you going to go after you graduate?

Will (Predictions/General Future):

- What country will you go to first when you have enough money?

Questions with Do - Irregular Verb

- **Definition:** To perform an action or task.

Going to (Plans):

- What are you going to do this coming weekend?

Will (Predictions/Spontaneous):

- What will you do first when you get home from school today?

Questions with Want - Regular Verb

- **Definition:** To desire something but not necessarily require it.

Going to (Plans/Intentions):

- What are you going to want to eat after school today?

Will (Future Desires):

- What kind of job will you want after you graduate?

Questions with Need - Regular Verb

- **Definition:** To require something because it is necessary or important.

Going to (Plans):

- What are you going to need for your next vacation?

Will (Predictions):

- What skills do you think people will need to learn in the future?
