Noun Definition

A noun is a word that names something, such as a person, place, thing, or idea.

Nouns Examples:



PERSON	brother, lawyer, classmate, Chris
PLACE	Spain, city, bedroom, school
ANIMAL	dog, monkey, cat, bird
THING	pencil, bag , cellphone, car,
IDEA	justice, freedom, love

Proper Vs Common Nouns



A **proper noun** is a specific name of a person, place, or thing, and is always capitalized.

Examples: England, Kelly, The Sun

A **common noun** is the generic name of an item and is not capitalized (unless it's at the beginning of a sentence or in a title.)

Examples: pencil, river, bike

Singular vs Plural Nouns



When you are talking about one thing, a **singular noun** is used.

Example: pencil, tree, bike

When you are talking about more than one thing, a **plural noun** is used.

Example: pencils, trees, bikes

Plural Noun Rules



Let's look at how to change a
singular noun into a plural
noun....



Rule no.1

To make regular nouns plural,
add **-s** to the end.



one camera



two cameras**s**



one cup



three cups**s**



Rule no.2

If the singular noun ends in -s, -ss, -sh, -ch, -x, or -z, add **-es** to the end to make it plural.



one box



two box**es**



one bus



two bus**es**



Rule no.3

If a singular noun ends in -y and the letter before the -y is a consonant, change the ending to **-ies** to make the noun plural.



one puppy



two puppies



one bunny



two bunnies

Rule no.4



If the singular noun ends in -o, add **-es** to make it plural.



one
tomato



three
tomato**es**



one
volcano



two
volcano**es**

Rule no.5



Some nouns don't change at all when they're pluralized.



one sheep



two **sheep**



one deer



two **deer**



Rule no.6

Nouns that are irregular, don't follow any particular rules.



one mouse



two mice



one child



two
children
