Canada is often characterized as being "very progressive, diverse, and multicultural".

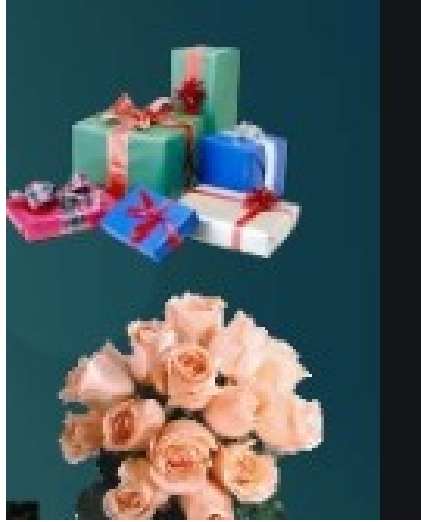

Famous Canadian Foods

Poutine

-is a dish that includes french fries and cheese curds topped with a brown gravy. It originated in the Canadian province of Quebec.



PEAMEAL BACON

is a wet-cured, unsmoked back bacon made from trimmed lean boneless pork loin rolled in cornmeal and is found mainly in Southern Ontario.

CAESAR

This cocktail is a Classic Canadian Caesar Recipe, perfect for brunch or to cure a hangover. This cocktail consists of vodka, tomato juice, spices and a few secret ingredients, similar to a Bloody Mary.





CANADIAN PIZZA

- **Canadian pizza — typically includes tomato sauce, mozzarella cheese, bacon, pepperoni, and mushrooms; variations exist.)**

BUTTER TART

A butter tart is a type of small pastry tart highly regarded in Canadian cuisine and considered one of Canada's quintessential treats. The sweet tart consists of a filling of butter, sugar, syrup, and egg, baked in a pastry shell until the filling is semi-solid with a crunchy top.



NANAIMO BAR

- The Nanaimo bar is a dessert item of Canadian origin. It is a bar dessert which requires no baking and is named after the city of Nanaimo, British Columbia, on Vancouver Island.
