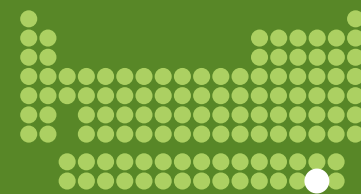

DISCOVERY

NAME



Nobelium is named after Alfred Nobel, the inventor of dynamite and founder of the Nobel Prizes.

SYNTHESIS



The most common isotope, No-255, is commonly made by firing carbon-12 at californium-249.
