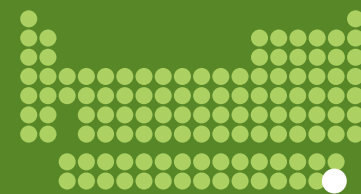

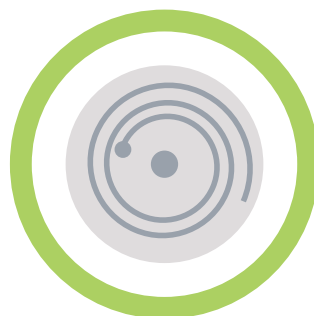


### DISCOVERY



Credit for the discovery of lawrencium was given jointly to scientists from the U.S. and the Soviet Union.

### NAME



Lawrencium is named after Ernest Lawrence, who invented the cyclotron particle accelerator.

### SHORT-LIVED



Lawrencium is only made in miniscule amounts, and its most stable isotope has a half-life of just ten hours.
