Noun Definition

A noun is a word that names something, such as a person place, thing, or idea.

Nouns Examples:

PERSON brother, lawyer, classmate, Ch

PLACE Spain, city, bedroom, school

ANIMAL dog, monkey, cat, bird

THING pencil, bag, cellphone, car,

IDEA justice, freedom, love

Proper Vs Common Nouns

A proper noun is a specific name of a person, place, or thing, ar always capitalized.

Examples: England, Kelly, The Sun

A common noun is the generic name of an item and is not capito (unless it's at the beginning of a sentence or in a title.)

Examples: pencil, river, bike

Singular vs Plural Nouns

When you are talking about one thing, a singular nour used.

Example: pencil, tree, bike

When you are talking about more than one thing, a plu noun is used.

Example: pencils, trees, bikes

Plural Noun Rules

Let's look at how to change singular noun into a plural noun....

To make regular nouns plural, add -s to the end.



If the singular noun ends in -s, -ss, -sh ch, -x, or -z, add -es to the end to mak plural.







one bus

two bu

If a singular noun ends in -y and the letter before the -y is a consonant, change the ending to -ies to make the noun plural.









one puppy

two puppies

one bunny

two buni

If the singular noun ends in -o, add -es make it plural.



one tomato



three tomatoes



one volcano



two volcanc

Some nouns don't change at all whe they're pluralized.









one sheep

two sheep

one deer

two de

Nouns that are irregular, don't follow of particular rules.



one mouse



two mice



one child



two childr
